BISHOP WILLIAM WALTERSHEID


Auxiliary Bishop of Pittsburgh, who grew up near Gettysburg and Emmitsburg, will accompany us on this pilgrimage. Bishop has a deep appreciation of the spiritual and historical significance of this area.



Saturday May 25, 2019 - We depart from St. Paul Seminary by private motor coach at 7:30AM (you may leave your vehicle here-please arrive by 7:15AM). Upon arrival in Emmitsburg, we honor Saint Elizabeth Ann Seton, the foundress of the Sisters of Charity and the first American Saint. In late June 1863, the Civil War arrived on the doorstep of the Sisters of Charity when the Union Army encamped on their lawn. Mother Seton's former home, the White House, became a Union general's office, where he plotted strategy for the impending battle, changing the course of the war. After the battle of Gettysburg, many Sisters of Charity served as nurses and bravely tended to the soldiers, they were called "angels of the battlefield" by both the Union and Confederate soldiers. Bishop Waltersheid will celebrate Mass in the Basilica of the National Shrine of Mother Seton, where she is entombed. We will tour the Seton complex and enjoy a catered lunch. We continue to our hotel, on the outskirts of Gettysburg and check in. After freshening up, we journey into Gettysburg for shopping and exploration. Dinner tonight will be at the famous Dobbin House in Gettysburg. After dinner, we enjoy a private visit to the Gettysburg Diorama and History Center, which will serve to enhance our understanding of the battle, before our tour of the battlefields!

Sunday May 26, 2019 – This morning, Bishop will celebrate Mass for us at St. Francis Xavier Church, which was an emergency hospital during the battle. We visit the Gettysburg National Military Park Museum and Visitor Center to view the fantastic Cyclorama, watch the movie and then enjoy a leisurely visit of the different floors of the museum. We have free time for lunch at the museum restaurant. Then, we experience one of the highlights of our pilgrimage, a tour of the battlefield with a licensed guide. We will stop at the statue of Father William Corby, to pay homage to this holy hero. Our last stop today will be the cemetery and the Lincoln Memorial where we read aloud the Gettysburg address. We enjoy dinner at the Mason Dixon Distillery, where we have the opportunity to tour its works! Overnight at our hotel.

Monday May 27, 2019 – After breakfast, we enjoy a guided tour of the Seminary Ridge Museum. Located in the historic seminary building, which stood at the center of the first day's battle, this museum connects us to the circumstances which led to the Civil War. It provides a powerful and personal view of the battle's first day, and shows the work of one of the battlefield's largest hospitals where the Sisters of Charity tended the wounded. Some energetic pilgrims may decide, to take this opportunity and climb the cupola – for the same sweeping view that Union General John Buford saw from this very spot! After touring the museum, we enjoy a buffet lunch at a restaurant, situated close to the Gettysburg Memorial Day Parade route. After lunch, we have the option of watching the parade, weather permitting, or having a walk around Gettysburg. At 3PM we will depart from Gettysburg, stopping en route at the Lourdes Shrine, to celebrate Mass. We hope to arrive back at St. Paul Seminary around 9PM, with stories to tell and experiences to remember for many years to come!

HOTEL ACCOMMODATIONS: Specially selected hotel based on twin occupancy with private bath. Single Room supplement of \$130 will be charged when requested and available. If you do not have a roommate and A Pilgrim's Journey is unable to arrange one, you will be billed for the single room supplement. All singles are subject to availability. **MEALS: INCLUDED** as stated in itinerary. Beverages are not included with dinner or lunch, unless stated. **TIPS AND TAXES:** Tips and taxes normally appearing on hotel and restaurant bills as service are included, as are all government and local taxes on hotels and meals, One suitcase per person on bus. Tip to driver and Gettysburg battleground guide at your discretion. Collection at Mass. **NOT INCLUDED:** Expenses and items not specifically mentioned in itinerary are NOT covered.
