GUADALUPE PILGRIMAGE ITINERARY

Monday, March 18—DAY 1 FLY TO MEXICO CITY

We depart from our hometowns for Mexico City. Upon arrival, we transfer by private air-conditioned motor coach to our hotel, where we stay for 5 nights. The rest of the day is at leisure. Dinner at our hotel in Mexico City.

Tuesday, March 19—DAY 2 BASILICA DE GUADALUPE

After breakfast, included daily, we visit the Basilica de Guadalupe. In December 1531, the Virgin appeared to Juan Diego, a peasant Indian, and asked him to build a church. After hearing this story, the local bishop asked for proof. Juan Diego returned on December 12, his cloak full of roses that the Virgin had told him to collect. When the cloak was opened, the flowers had disappeared and a vivid image of the virgin appeared in the folds of the cloth. We celebrate Mass in Guadalupe, and visit the five churches dedicated to our Lady, the last one was completed in 1976. After lunch, on our own, we continue to Teotihuacan and visit the archeological site to view the pyramids. Dinner and overnight at our hotel.

Wednesday, March 20—DAY 3 IGLESIA DE LA SANTA FAMILIA

This morning we visit the Parroquia de la Sagrada Familia. We celebrate Mass and visit the Shrine of Blessed Miguel Pro, the Jesuit priest who was executed in 1926 at the hands of the government. On to Coyoacan, and a visit San Juan Bautista, a 16th century Catholic church and former mission dedicated to Saint John the Baptist. It is located in the Hidalgo garden. It preserves its original sober quarry facade and its bell tower consists of four sections and ending in a single octagonal tower. We continue to Xochimilco and enjoy a traditional trajinera canal boat ride- riding on the floating canals and gardens. We return to our hotel for dinner and overnight.

Thursday, March 21—DAY 4 CUERNAVACA AND TAXCO

After breakfast, we visit Cuernavaca and see one of the oldest churches in Mexico; construction began in 1525, and finally in 1891 it was elevated to the rank of Cathedral of Our Lady of the Assumption. We continue to Taxco, for a visit of Santa Prisca Church, a masterpiece of Baroque art. Legend says it was built with the silver of Taxco by one of the richest men in the world, the French miner Joseph de Laborde, to atone the many sins. We celebrate Mass in Santa Prisca. Dinner and overnight at our hotel.

Friday, March 22—DAY 5 PUEBLA

We enjoy a special outing today to Puebla. Upon arrival we visit the Sanctuary of Our Lady of the Remedies; consecrated in 1594, it continues to serve as a location of prayer during times of drought. According to legend, the city, during Pre-Hispanic times had 365 temples (one for each day of the year), eventually Cortés had a Christian temple built on top of each of them. Today 39 churches remain; only Rome has more! The first church we visit is Temple de Santa Maria Tonantzintla, a 16th century church with a most unique design called "indigenous Baroque". We continue to Puebla Cathedral of Our Lady of the Immaculate Conception. It is one of the most important buildings in the historic center declared a World Heritage site. We celebrate Mass and have free time for shopping before journeying back to Mexico City. Tonight we toast our pilgrimage with a special dinner. Overnight at our hotel.

Saturday, March 23—DAY 6 RETURN HOME

After breakfast, we transfer to the airport for our flight home- with stories to share and memories to last a lifetime.
